# 2. SUPERVISOR REQUESTS AND AUDIENCE QUESTIONS AND COMMENT ON

Beth Wimberly and Michelle Mayfield both addressed the Board of Supervisors regarding their encroachment agreements. Both stated they were late, but they had been waiting for information to come back from Meritus on various matters. They felt their agreements should be approved because they tried their best to comply. They also felt the timeline was too tight, the agreement was not clear, etc.. Supervisor Cockerell asked why they did not just drop off their agreements. Supervisor Lavina thought the agreement did not read like an application and to her the agreement seemed like it would be approved automatically. Supervisor Bly said they voted no because no applications had been turned in, but he was alright with approving if there were extenuating circumstances. Supervisor Cockerell corrected owners that agreements were not approved and then denied, the agreements are reviewed on a case by case basis. Supervisor Cockerell also stated that if renewals are not submitted they will be deemed unapproved when they expire. Mr. Howell confirmed he had given extensions to the Mayfields because Mr. Mayfield was out of town. The Board directed Mr. Howell to work with Mr. Vericker to review the agreement and make sure it is clear, concise and included all fees.

The board was advised a palm had died and tested positive for weevils which carry a virus that will infect palms and eventually kill them. The only way to manage the problem is to treat the palms prior to them getting infected on a routine quarterly program. The Board agreed it was cheaper to treat the palms versus replacing mature ones.
