This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet residential needs. The Audience Comment portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. Each individual is limited to three (3) minutes for such comment. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

Public workshops sessions may be advertised and held in an effort to provide informational services. These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

- 1. Rear of bus stop: Re-trench brick wall to keep mulch contained within the bed.
- 2. Bus stop: Remove stubs from Ligustrum Privet near fire hydrant.
- 3. Casa Lago Lane intersection: Continue to hand prune Bottlebrush as needed so they do not overgrow the sidewalk.
- 4. Remove staking and strapping material from trees once trees are firmly rooted.
- 5. Highland Park entrance, at the clock: Improve the grading around irrigation valve boxes and top dress with clean mulch to neaten the appearance.
- 6. Frontage: Reduce tree limbs. Raise undercanopies of trees for pedestrian and vehicle clearance.
- 7. Remove Spanish Moss up to 15 feet from trees.

- 11. Bevel sidewalk edge of Asiatic Jasmine plantings, eliminating the vertical sheared appearance. Jasmine plantings should have a tapered appearance.

12. Splendid Lane entrance: Remove viney and weedy growth from Juniper plantings.

- 13. Remove windfall and storm debris throughout park right-of-way and retention area.
- 14. Throughout Splendid Park, entrance, and right-of-ways: Continue removing dead material and control weeds in beds.

COMMONS

- 15. Fertilize Viburnum hedgerow along north perimeter.
- 16. Rake down fire ant mounds once insects have been eradicated.

BOURNEMOUTH

- 17. Pocket prune Fire Bush as plants flush with new growth to maintain a flowering shrub at approximately 36 inches.
- 18. Throughout commons and perimeter parking lot: Prune and elevate trees as needed, maintaining.

- 29. Throughout common entrance area: Monitor street tree height, maintaining service vehicle clearance.
- 30. Complete all turf mowables.

- 31. Citrus Park Drive frontage: Re-define soft lines, promoting uniform bed lines.
- 32. Entrance median island: Haystack prune Fountain Grass once bloom cycle is complete.
