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Executive Summary September 29, 2017

Executive Summary

Park Place Community Development District (CDD) has contracted with Stantec Consulting Services Inc. to review the Canopy Drive corridor between Casa Lago Lane and Splendid Lane. The residents have voiced concern about speeders through this section of roadway.

The CDD has provided speed data from a previous study for Stantec's review and analysis. Stantec has also conducted a field review and meeting with local representative to assess the existing conditions and find the most feasible location for traffic control devices.



Based on the field review and discussion it was concluded that the residents would prefer speed tables. One speed table is recommended at the west end of the corridor, about 50 feet east of the Casa Lago Lane intersection, and one speed table at the east end of the corridor, about 114 feet west of the Splendid Lane intersection.

1.0 ASSESSMENT

1.1 FIELD REVIEW

Canopy Drive is located in the Highlands Park neighborhood, in the Park Place Community Development District (CDD). The neighborhood is located in Hillsborough County, north-west of Tampa off Race Track Road. Highland Park was developed with new urbanism concept which promotes pedestrian-friendly interconnection. The neighborhood includes large areas of brick paver roadways that are making use of salvaged street pavers to give it a unique appearance, but due to the surface texture also aids as a traffic calming device. The section of Canopy drive included in this assessment is located just east of a brick paver plaza area, but the roadway surface change to asphalt. It is our observation that this transition from pavers to asphalt might be a contributor to the apparent higher eastbound speeds in this section. East of the section Canopy Drive is a narrow one-way street. It changes to a two-way section at Splendid Lane. This transition from the narrow one-way street to wider two-lane section is an apparent contributor to the higher westbound speeds.



Figure 1: Typical Brick Paver section west of Canopy Drive

The posted speed limit on Canopy Drive is 15 MPH. The residents on Canopy drive have observed speeding through this section of the street. The CDD had a speed study performed in May 2017. Based on the speed study information there are approximately 1,000 vehicles per day using this section of road. See Section 1.2 for speed study assessment.

There are about 10 houses located in the study area. The lots along Canopy drive are approximately 70 feet frontages, with alternating driveways. This does not provide much room for typical traffic calming devices. Stantec has discussed three options with the neighborhood representative; speed bumps, speed humps and speed tables. See Section 1.3 for discussion of these devices.

Based on our review and discussion, it is our understanding that he neighborhood would prefer speed tables, with the same brick surface that is being used elsewhere in the neighborhood. Typical Speed tables are 22 feet in length. Due to the limited room available between driveways, it is recommended that modified shorter speed tables be installed. One speed table is recommended at the west end of the corridor, approximately 40 feet east of the Casa Lago intersection, and one speed table at the east end, approximately 114 feet west of Splendid Lane.

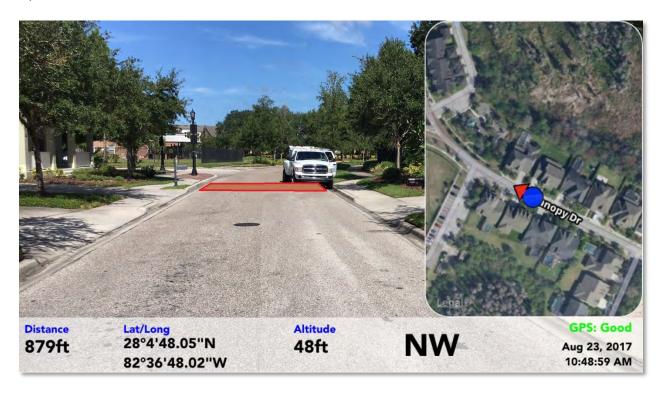


Figure 3: Proposed speed table 1 - west location

1.2 SPEED STUDY

The residents have voiced concern about speeding in the neighborhood, especially on Canopy Drive between Casa Lago Lane and Splendid Lane. The posted speed limit on Canopy Drive is 15 MPH. A speed limit sign with radar detector and speed display have been installed.

The CDD had a speed study conducted in May 2017 over a period of two weeks. The speed study data indicates that approximately 50% of the vehicles exceeded the speed limit. Approximately 36% of vehicles travel between 15 MPH and 20 MPH with 14% exceeding 20 MPH. The highest speed recorded was 52 MPH one occasion, with daily highest speeds in the 34 MPH range. The average vehicle speed over the two weeks of the study was consistently 14 MPH.

Based on the speed study data traffic calming devices are not necessarily recommended, but would be provided as a resident requested option.

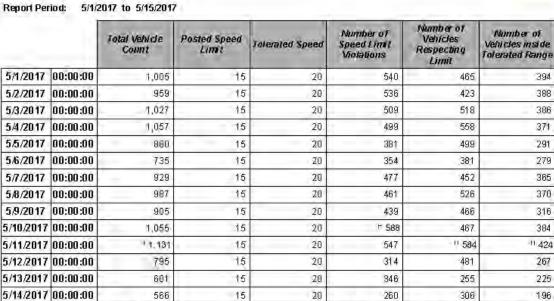

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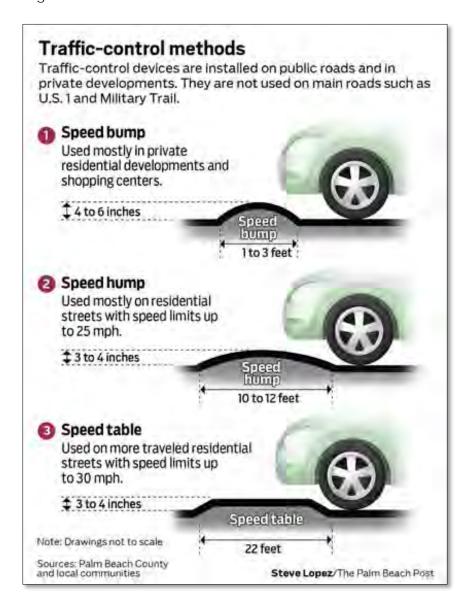

1.3 TRAFFIC CALMING DEVICES

Different traffic calming devices have been considered for this location. Several devices such as chicanes (horizontal deflection) and other street narrowing devices are not feasible due to the frequent locations of driveways. These devices require longer stretches of roadway to be implemented.

The viable options for Canopy Drive are speed bumps, speed humps or speed tables. Speed tables are the recommended application at this location. Due to limited room between driveways a modified shorter speed table will be recommended. Resident representative has also indicated a preference for speed tables with brick paver surface to match the neighborhood crosswalks and street sections.



Recommendation September 29, 2017

2.0 RECOMMENDATION

Based on our assessment of the data provided and our field assessment, we have evaluated different options for traffic calming devices. It was concluded that speed tables will be the most viable type device for Canopy Drive.

Speed tables are typically about 22 feet in length. Due to the limited space available between driveways along Canopy Drive, a shorter table is recommended. This modified table will be similar in length to a speed hump, approximately 10 feet, but will have a flat top with brick paver surface to match the streets and crosswalks in the neighborhood.
