The Board, Staff and John Wegner reviewed the proposals for the Race Track Road irrigation,

sod and buffer area. They also reviewed the option of just adding trees on the inside of the wall on the Lake Dagny side. The owners present from Lake Dagny were opposed to that option. The Board discussed the cost of the job and whether it was a good use of dollars to do a buffer for just a few owners in the Lake Dagny neighborhood. Originally the project just started out as irrigation and sod for Race Track Road. The Board discussed needing more info for the different size trees and Mr. Wegner will send pictures. The Board discussed the request to add a fence to keep people from cutting through Lake Dagny from Race Track Road. A fence that is the same type as what is at clubhouse pool and will cost just a little over \$2,000.00.
